## ALONG LNER LINES

7.30pm Wednesday 14th October at  
*The Benn Hall, Newbold Road, RUGBY, Warks*

The old London & North Eastern Railway served almost all of the Eastern side of England and Scotland. As well as its flagship East Coast Main Line, the route of the legendary Flying Scotsman, it encompassed the last main line, the former Great Central route to London that was originally part of Sir Edward Watkin's grand plan to run trains direct from Manchester to Paris via the Channel Tunnel more than 100 years ago! Alas, the tunnel was not built but the route was connected to the Metropolitan and was built to the Continental loading gauge. It controversially succumbed to the Beeching axe 40 years ago and remains to this day a lost opportunity, victim of short term planning.

This new *London & North Eastern Railway* programme of rare archive films covers all aspects of LNER operations including some secondary routes and branch lines together with a special tribute to the *Great Central Railway* with visits to Annesley, Banbury and Neasden sheds in the 1930's; plus a unique film record of the very last of the old Metropolitan 4-4-OT's at work on the most northerly part of the Metropolitan Railway system, the Brill branch in 1928!

- \* The steam worked **Brill Tramway** - most Northerly outpost of the *London Transport* system!
