COB WALLING AT CLAVERDON, WARWKS.

This cob-constructed wall is approximately 72' long, 6' high and 2' wide. A shaped corrugated iron coping with a good overhang is in place to keep cob dry.

This wall is adjacent to a public road, Wheelbarrow Lane, O\S sheet 151 Ref. 291 648.

In this part of Warwickshire cob walling is quite rare.
