Former Railway Bridge High Street, Leamington Spa

In the 1960s the over bridges at Lower Avenue, Bath Place, High Street, Court Street and Althorpe Street were all removed. As the Railway line had been closed there was no point in maintaining these structures so all were dismantled. I think the removal of High Street bridge had little to do with Midland Red buses as it was 22 feet above road level. I believe the large stone blocks in the children's play area at Victoria Park originated from one of these sites.
