



## Guidance for visitors: Coronavirus (COVID-19)

In view of the current guidance on minimising the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19), individuals who fall into the following categories must not visit our campus at this time.

Anyone who has returned recently from any of the following areas even if they do not have any symptoms of illness:	Anyone who has returned from the following areas in the past 14 days, and who is showing any symptoms consistent with coronavirus (cough, fever, or shortness of breath) even if the symptoms are mild:
