

## <u>Visit to Kempton Great Engines and London Museum of Steam and Water</u> Sunday March 19<sup>th</sup> 2017

Arrangements have now been finalised for this coach trip. Cost per head will be £29.50 which includes the admission fees to both the Kempton Great Engines and the Kew Museum. Please note that tickets are non refundable, except in the event of the trip being oversubscribed, when refunds may be possible. Numbers are limited to 30, so it is first come first served.

The coach will leave from the car park at Newbold Comyn, Newbold Terrace East, Royal Learnington Spa, opposite the Newbold Comyn Leisure Centre at 08:30 prompt and will return there sometime after 18:00. We are aiming to arrive at Kempton Great Engines for when they open at 10:30. We will then leave Kempton to travel to Kew around 13:00. We will leave Kew at 16:00. The Kempton engine will be in steam, but unfortunately due to maintenance there will be no stationary engines in steam at Kew. Hopefully, the narrow gauge railways at both locations will be operating. The ticket price includes guided tours at each location. The ticket will serve as your admission ticket to both museums, so please make sure you bring it with you on the day.
